

## How to find App Developers with Boolean search strings

Use Boolean logic on Google to find resumes and profiles of App Developers. Our search strings examples provide a basis to build your own Boolean search commands. Modify them to recruit [developers](#) who can build intuitive and functional applications.

### Generic search string to find App Developers

Build Boolean search string for app developers according to your needs:

- -job -jobs -sample -examples, to avoid irrelevant results
- (intitle:resume OR intitle:cv), to discover candidates' online resumes or CVs
- ("app developer" OR "application developer"), to cover variations of the same job title

Here's an example of a generic search string that you can further modify to find resumes:

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("app developer" OR "application developer") -job -jobs -sample -examples*

When running this command on Google, you'll get results that include the words "resume" or "CV" in the page title. Excluding more terms reduces false positives.

### Searching for App Developer profiles

Search for developers on specific sites, like Github and [Stack Overflow](#), through Google by including the site: operator and terms found exclusively on member profiles. For example:

- *site:github.com "app developer" "joined on"*
- *site:stackoverflow.com/users/ "badges" "app developer"*

Add more criteria in your Boolean strings for app developers to find profiles that better match your requirements.

## Sample string to search for resumes of App Developers in various formats:

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) (filetype:pdf OR filetype:doc OR filetype:txt) "app developer" -job -jobs -sample -templates*

## Examples of Boolean search strings to find App Developers by coding experience and skills

### Find App Developers who:

#### Know various coding languages

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("app developer" OR "app programmer") (Java OR swift) "Objective-C" -job -jobs -sample -examples*

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("app developer" OR "application developer") PHP HTML5 -job -jobs -sample -examples*

#### Are familiar with user experience design

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("app developer" OR "application developer") (UI OR UX) -job -jobs -sample -examples*

#### Have cross-platform experience

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("app developer" OR "application developer") iOS Android -job -jobs -sample -examples*

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("app developer" OR "application developer") (PhoneGap OR Cordova) -job -jobs -sample -examples*

#### Have experience with J2EE, Ajax or both

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("app developer" OR "application developer") (J2EE OR Ajax) -job -jobs -sample -examples*

#### Are familiar with agile methodologies and the ASP .NET framework

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("app developer" OR "application developer") (scrum OR crystal) "ASP .NET" -job -jobs -sample -examples*

## Examples of Boolean search strings to find App Developers by location

### By state or city:

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) "app developer" ("New York" OR NY) -job -jobs -sample -examples*

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) "app developer" Dallas (Texas OR TX) -job -jobs -sample -examples*

### By area code:

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) "app developer" Chicago (773 OR 872) -job -jobs -sample -examples*

### Within range of zip codes:

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) "app developer" (California OR CA) 90001..90089 -job -jobs -sample -examples*
