## How to find Game Developers with Boolean search strings

Use Boolean logic to find resumes and profiles [on Google](#) to hire Game Developers. Our search string examples provide a basis to build your own Boolean commands. Modify them to [recruit developers](#) with experience building, troubleshooting and testing games.

### Generic search string to find Game Developers

Build Boolean strings for game developers according to your needs:

- -job -jobs -sample -examples, to avoid irrelevant results
- (Developer OR engineer), to cover variations of the same job title
- (intitle:resume OR intitle:cv), to discover candidates' online resumes or CVs

Here's an example of a generic search string that you can further modify to find resumes:

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("game developer" OR "game programmer") -job -jobs -sample -examples*

When running this [command in Google](#), you'll get results that include the words "resume" or "CV" in the page title. Excluding more terms reduces false positives.

### Searching for Game Developer profiles

Search for [Game Developers](#) on specific sites through Google by including the site: operator and terms found exclusively on member profiles. For example:

- *site:github.com "game developer" "joined on"*
- *site:stackoverflow.com/users/ "badges" "game developer"*

Add more criteria in your Boolean search string for game developers to find profiles that better match your requirements.

## Sample string to search for resumes of Game Developers in various formats:

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) (filetype:pdf OR filetype:doc OR filetype:txt) "game developer" -job -jobs -sample -templates*

## Examples of Boolean search strings to find Developers with varying specialities

### Find Game Developers who:

#### Can code in various programming languages

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("game developer" OR "game programmer") Java HTML5 -job -jobs -sample -examples*

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("game developer" OR "game programmer") (C# OR C++) -job -jobs -sample -examples*

#### Are familiar with specific game consoles

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("game developer" OR "game programmer") (Xbox OR Sony)-job -jobs -sample -examples*

#### Have developed games for mobile (Android or iOS)

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("game developer" OR "game programmer") (Android OR iOS) -job -jobs -sample -examples*

#### Have experience with certain game engines

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("game developer" OR "game programmer") (Unity3D OR Unreal) -job -jobs -sample -examples*

#### Are familiar with animation

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("game developer" OR "game programmer") "3D animation" -job -jobs -sample -examples*

## Examples of Boolean search strings to find Game Developers by location

## By state or city:

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) "game developer" (Oregon OR OR) -job -jobs -sample -examples*

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) "game developer" Miami (Florida OR FL) -job -jobs -sample -examples*

## By area code:

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) "game developer" (Massachusetts OR MA) (857 OR 617) -job -jobs -sample -examples*

## Within range of zip codes:

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) "game developer" (Massachusetts OR MA) 02108..02495 -job -jobs -sample -examples*
