
How to find .NET Web Developers with Boolean search strings

Boolean search can help you find profiles and resumes to hire [.NET Web Developers](#). These Developers specialize in the .NET web framework and focus on its web applications. We built our example search strings around relevant web technologies. Modify and run them on Google based on your needs.

Generic search string to find .NET Web Developers

To start looking for resumes, we need to include the word “resume,” “cv,” “bio” or other variations in our search strings. Use the *intitle:* and *inurl:* operators to target results that contain these word in the page title or page urls (and are therefore more likely to be relevant results.) Also, use the *NOT (-) operator* to exclude false positives.

Here’s a basic search string that you can further modify:

(intitle:resume OR inurl:resume) “.NET web developer” -job -jobs -templates -sample -examples

Searching for .NET Web Developers profiles

Use Boolean search to find .NET Web Developers on programming sites like [GitHub](#) and [Stack Overflow](#). An added benefit of finding candidates on these sites is that you can directly evaluate their work and contributions to open source projects.

Include the *site:* operator and terms found exclusively on member profiles. For example:

- *site:github.com “.NET developer” “contribution activity”*
- *site:stackoverflow.com/users/ “badges” “.NET web developer”*

Add more criteria in your search (e.g. location) to find profiles that better match your requirements.

Examples of Boolean search strings to find .NET Web Developers by experience and knowledge

Find .NET Web Developers who:

Are familiar with the Entity Framework

(intitle:resume OR inurl:resume) ".NET Web Developer" Entity -job -jobs -sample -examples

Have used architectural patterns like Model-View-Controller and Model-View-Presenter

(intitle:resume OR inurl:resume) ".NET Web Developer" (MVP OR MVC) -job -jobs -sample -examples

Have worked with the RESTful API

(intitle:resume OR inurl:resume) ".NET Web Developer" REST -job -jobs -sample -examples -hire

Know C#

(intitle:resume OR inurl:resume) ".NET Web Developer" C# -job -jobs -sample -examples

Have worked with specific .NET content management systems

(intitle:resume OR inurl:resume) ".NET Developer" (Umbraco OR DNN) -job -jobs -sample -examples -hire

Are familiar with .NET's object-relational mappers

(intitle:resume OR inurl:resume) ".NET Developer" NHibernate -job -jobs -sample -examples -bistro -hire -jobvertise

Examples of Boolean search strings to find .NET Web Developers by location

By state or city:

(intitle:resume OR inurl:resume) .NET "Web Developer" (California OR CA) -job -jobs -sample -examples -indeed -hire -resumes

(intitle:resume OR inurl:resume) .NET "Web Developer" Boston MA -job -jobs -sample -examples -indeed -hire
