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## HR consultant average salary

Human Resources consultant salary amounts to an average of \$64,008 in the US, according to data from Glassdoor. Payscale indicates a slightly higher average HR consultant salary of \$67,591. Their combined average is \$65,799. The upper 10 percent of HR consultants are paid more than \$100,000, while the lowest 10 percent earns less than \$44,000. In consultancy firms, HR consultants may be additionally rewarded with bonuses.

### Career Outlook

HR consultants with less than five years of experience earn \$60,000 on average according to Payscale. In their mid-career their salary rises to \$71,000. In their first decade as experienced HR Consultants they earn \$81,000 and after 20 years they can be paid up to \$94,000 on average.

When HR Consultants are employed in consultancy firms they typically report to Lead Consultants in HR. They can become Lead consultants after several years of experience. In other settings, they may advance to the position of HR Manager or HR Director. Benefits manager is another, though less common, career path.
