## How to find Physicians with Boolean search strings

Use Boolean logic on Google to recruit [Physicians](#) with various backgrounds and specializations. Our search strings examples provide a basis to build your own commands and find physicians for your health care organization.

### Recruiting Physicians with generic Boolean strings

Build search according to your needs:

- -job -jobs -sample -examples, to reduce false positives.
- *intitle:* or *inurl:* operator, to include the word “resume” or “CV” in the page title or page url respectively.

Here’s an example of a generic search string that you can further modify to find resumes:

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) physician -job -jobs -sample -examples*

Use *OR* operators to expand your results with a single search. For example, use (oncologist OR radiologist), to look for both oncologists and radiologists.

### Searching for Physician profiles

Run Boolean strings on Google to find Physicians on social platforms and forums. Use the site: operator and terms found exclusively on member profiles. For example:

- *site:doximity.com “is on Dexterity” urologist*

Add more criteria in your search to find profiles that better match your requirements.

### Examples of Boolean search strings to recruit Physicians by specialization and experience

## Find Physicians who:

### Have various medical specialties

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) (oncologist OR radiologist) -job -jobs -sample -examples*

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) psychiatrist -job -jobs -sample -examples*

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) OB GYN -job -jobs -sample -examples*

### Are primary care physicians

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("family practitioner" OR "general practitioner") -job -jobs -sample -examples*

### Have a background in epidemiology

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) physician epidemiology -job -jobs -sample -examples*

### Have worked in the ER

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) ("ER physician" OR "worked in the ER") -job -jobs -sample -examples*

### Have experience in intensive care

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) physician ("intensive care" OR "critical care") -job -jobs -sample -examples*

### Have published their work

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) physician ("published research" OR "published paper") -job -jobs -sample -examples*

## Sample string to search for resumes of Physicians in various formats

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) (filetype:pdf OR filetype:doc OR filetype:txt) physician -job -jobs -sample -templates*

## Recruiting Physicians by location with Boolean search strings

### By state or city:

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) neurologist (California OR CA) -job -jobs -sample -examples -template*

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) "orthopedic surgeon" "Los Angeles" -job -jobs -sample -examples*

## **By area codes:**

*(intitle:resume OR intitle:cv) pediatrician Chicago (773 OR 312 OR 872) -job -jobs -sample -templates*
